- 🚊 Take tram line 2 from Darmstadt Central Station in the direction of TU-Lichtwiese/Campus and get off at the last stop (TU-Lichtwiese/Campus) or take bus line L from bus stops Luisenplatz or Schloss in the direction of TU-Lichtwiese/Campus. You can also take the regional train directly to Darmstadt TU-Lichtwiese Bahnhof. From there, it is just a short walk to the Lecture Hall and Media Centre (HMZ).
